Message from the Director of Golf

Golf rates starting Wednesday, May 6 through the end of the month are now 50% off our advertised prices for residents and public play. These rates do not apply to any membership plans. [CLICK HERE](#)

Starting on Friday, May 8, we will allow up to two people at a time in the pro shop who are looking to purchase merchandise only. Our check-in process will continue with a host out in front of the shop to check you in and a tee host on the tee to get you started until further notice.

The reconstruction of the golf course greens, practice putting green, short-game area, and driving range tee is going as planned and on schedule. We will remain open during construction as a par 68 starting on hole #10 — the maximum distance of approximately 5,000 yards. However, on Monday, May 11 and Tuesday, May 12, we will have holes 15 and 16 closed for construction. On those two days we will only have 16 holes available to play. We adjusted the rates at 50% off to accommodate for the inconvenience.

Also, don't forget we still have to aerify the fairways the month of May and June. On Tuesday, May 26 - Friday, May 29, holes 10-18 will be closed. We will only have nine holes available during this time. You can still play 18 holes; we will block you a turn time to accommodate for playing 18 holes. When booking a starting time, make sure you note

whether you're playing 9 or 18 holes. The following week Monday, June 1 - Friday, June 5, holes 1-9 will be closed with nine holes only available on holes 10-18, and again you can still play the same nine twice for your 18 hole round.

Thank you for taking the time to review the following guidelines we have created to play golf at The Views Golf Club during the continued COVID-19 concerns. Lesson Tee

Choose a Specific Target

One of the most important things you can do to lower your score and improve your game is to choose a particular target for each shot that you hit. When you have a specific target in mind as you swing, you will be far more likely to stay committed to your swing and the shot. Indecision is a sure sign of doubt and a lack of focus in your game, which will affect your ability to play your best.

It does not matter what kind of shot you are hitting; it is always essential to choose a target while you are going through your pre-shot routine, and before you take your stance. While some golfers may pick a target when hitting an approach shot, it does not seem as prevalent off of the tee. When the average golfer uses their driver off the tee, they usually in general just aim 'for the fairway' before taking a swinging. That isn't good enough, as far as target-selection is concerned. Rather than aiming for the fairway in general, choose a specific target in the distance. It could be a tree, mountain top, or even a cloud in the sky that you can focus on while you swing.

Once you get into the habit of choosing specific targets, you will see just how useful this strategy can be to help you hit more fairways, greens, and to lower your score. You will naturally start to create more confidence and commitment behind each shot and swing, and you will also begin to feel like you have more margin for error on your shots. The mind is a powerful thing on and off the golf course, and while playing, you should get in the practice of training your mind on a particular target before each shot and swing, and I promise you it will pay big dividends in improving your game and score.
